## CIRCLE TIME



KG1 - During circle time, children shared their feelings and discussed about each other's feelings. They understood the importance of sharing, taking turns and finding solutions to social problems with the help of trusted adults. They took turns to colour a bunch of grapes.



KG2 - Children learnt to work together in a group by sharing things. Children understood the importance of sharing materials with others and played in groups of 2 or 3 with friends in class.





KG3 - Students understood the importance of sharing things equally with friends and suggested ways of taking care of each other, they made new friends and described what it is to be a good friend. They learnt to resolve social problems and discussed on the importance of saving water and drinking clean water.

## THEME TIME



KG1 - During Science Time, children learnt about pet animals, farm animals, jungle animals and water animals. They also learnt about their features and body parts. They identified the animals which live on land and in water. They learnt the importance of food and sorted food as healthy food and unhealthy food.

KG2 - Students were able to identify air vehicles, water vehicles and land vehicles as different means of transport. Children identified land transport and discussed about road safety.

KG3 - Students learnt about common plants, how they grow and ways to take care of them, different kinds of healthy food, effects of not eating healthy food, sources of water, importance of saving water and the different phenomena associated with water.


## LANGUAGE TIME



KG1 - Students were able to recognize letters O, P, Q, R, S, T and learnt familiar words that begin with the letters and formed back open curves.


KG2 - Students were able to recognize the letters 'Qq' and 'Xx', their sounds and familiar words that begin with the letters. They could sequence at least 3 events in a story. Students named and labelled daily life objects.

KG3 - Students learnt blends 'br', 'gr', digraphs '-ch', 'sh' and 'wh' and they learnt about using adjectives and engaging in conversations. Role plays were done to dramatize story narratives. Paragraph reading and writing were also done. Reading & writing assessments helped hone the literacy skills of the young learners.

KG1 - During Math time, KG1 students sang the number song from 1-10. They demonstrated how to give and take away up to 5 objects from a set of objects. The students identified the missing parts of objects/pictures.

They could also compare two objects based on their sizes, heights, and weights.

KG2 - Students were able to estimate more and less through visual representation. Number writing from 1 to 50 was done. Reinforcement of backward counting from 10 to 1 was also done.

KG3 - Students learnt the numbers and number names from 1 to 100. They arranged numbers from smallest to biggest and biggest to smallest (upto 20). Sorting and comparing objects and arranging them as per their sizes, measuring capacity using non-standard units were also done.

KG1 - Children kicked a ball forward by running up to the line. They walked on a narrow beam. KG1 students danced to music with various tempos.

KG2 - Students were able to balance themselves, stand on one foot and hop. Catch a ball and gallop like a horse.

KG3 - Students learnt to catch and throw a small ball with accuracy, jump and spin and they learnt to walk on a straight line and a curved line.

They ran smoothly and changed directions, started and stopped at different points quickly and jumped from a height of about 3 feet and over hurdles.

## ART TIME



KG1 - Children used fingers and whole arm movements to manipulate the objects, smudge, beat or pat clay and made simple objects with it. They constructed three dimensional structures using the blocks.

KG2 - Students were able to fold paper and make a paper fan and airplane. Buttoning and unbuttoning of shirt was done, students cut paper along curved lines and poured water from one glass to another.



KG3 - Students learnt to colour within the given outline. They also learnt to fold paper neatly and make some fruit shapes with paper. They used zipper and buttons correctly. The students also made an edible bracelet using fruit loops.

# SPECIAL EVENTS

New Parent Orientation- Parents of students who had joined KG on or after September 2025 were invited to a new parent orientation session on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2025. The session aimed to apprise parents about the learning methodology, curriculum and class schedule as well as teaching and learning practices followed at Al Khozama Kindergarten.

Cozy Pajama Day- Kindergarteners celebrated the 'Cozy Pajama Day' on 13th November 2025. The students came dressed up in pajamas and were treated to story time, video time and a fun dance time; the children also shared their snacks and popcorns with friends.

Story Characters Day- AKIS Kindergarten celebrated the Story Characters Day on 19<sup>th</sup> November 2025 as part of International Children's Day celebrations. The KG students came dressed up as their favourite fairy tale characters and spoke about the character in the 'Show & Tell' sessions conducted in the classes. The day ended with the kindergartners handing out 'Thank You cards' to driver uncles and janitor aunties as part of the SEE practice of 'Gratitude'.

KG Talents Day- Talents Day was celebrated in KG on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2025 to infuse the spirit of healthy competition in young learners. The various events conducted on Talents Day were Colouring Competition (KG1), Clay Modelling (KG1 & 2) and Dance Competition (all the KG grades). The students from each grade were adjudged in first, second and third positions and were felicitated with trophies and certificates by the Principal Ms Susan Ipe.

Bunnies Camp 4 - Bunnies Camp 4 was held on 17th & 18th of November 2025. The camp covered domains like intellectual and physical development, awareness on food and nutrition, exercises on grace and courtesy, creative skills, life skills and sensory development. The Bunnies camps focus on augmenting the physical, social, emotional and ethical development of the young learners.

SEE Assemblies - Value based learning being our key philosophy, SEE assemblies and practices are a crucial part of our curriculum. Class assemblies conducted by KG3 B on 6<sup>th</sup> November focused on the value 'Caring' (Compassion), KG3 C did an assembly on 10<sup>th</sup> November on the topic of 'Gratitude' and KG 3D selected 'Empathy' as the topic of their class assembly held on 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2025. The values were demonstrated through role plays, dance and speech on the topics.

SEE Practices - Students expressed their gratitude to the driver uncles and janitor aunties by handing out 'Thank You Cards' on 19<sup>th</sup> November 2025. Children were also made to design 'Gratitude' cards to one's parents using vegetable dye printing which was part of the creative domain of Bunnies Camp 4.
